

Forest Stewardship Tree Farmer of the Year 2023

Nominations are best received by June 10th, 2023.

Eligibility and Guidelines:

Must be a certified member of the American Tree Farm System (ATFS).

Must have a Forest Stewardship Management Plan.

Landowner's property must be located in the eastern or central KFS districts.

The award will follow the guidelines of the ATFS's Outstanding Tree Farmer of the Year Competition and the standards and guidelines of the Forest Stewardship Program.

Nomination Procedure:

State Forest Stewardship Landowner and Outstanding Tree Farmer of the Year Awards are combined into one award.

Kansas Forest Service foresters, members of ATFS, members of KACD, Forest Stewardship landowners and Kansas State Tree Farm Committee and KFA members are all invited to submit nominations for the Forest Stewardship Tree Farmer of the Year.

Award criteria will be based upon ATFS Outstanding Tree Farm of the Year guidelines and Forest Stewardship Program standards and guidelines. The KFA Board will select the award winner during their July meeting by majority vote.

Applications of nominees who do not receive the award will be kept on file as official nominations for the following year. The Rural Forestry Coordinator will be responsible for updating these nominations.

Awards Materials:

A sign will be presented to the winner each year that includes KACD, Forest Stewardship, Tree Farm, Walnut Council, KS Forestry Association and KFS logos, award title, landowner's name and year of the award.

In addition to the sign, an outstanding Tree Farmer of the Year plaque (includes a brass plate that must be engraved with the winner's name), and a \$200 gift certificate from KFA will be presented to the award winner.

The award will be presented by the State Forester, KACD Executive Director and Kansas Forestry Association President at the Fall Forestry Field Day and KACD annual meeting.

The KFA Program Director is responsible for awards materials and placing the awards order with ATFS a minimum of 30 days prior to the Fall Forestry Field Day.

Promotion:

The Rural Forestry Coordinator is responsible for promoting the award and award winners. The Rural Forestry Coordinator will nominate the Forest Stewardship Tree Farmer of the Year for the KWF Forest Conservationist CAP award by December 10th.
